

CHAPTER 10
CITY OF MAPLE LAKE

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CURFEW

10.01 HOURS

It shall be unlawful for a minor under the age of 18 years of age to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, or other public ground, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places between the hours of 10:00p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

10.02 PARENTING/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITY

It shall be unlawful for the parent or guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of 18 years of age to permit such minor to violate subdivision 10.01

10.03 EXCEPTION

The provision of this chapter shall not apply when:

- A. The minor is physically accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor;
- B. The minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor; or
- C. The minor is on a direct route to, is attending, or is on a direct route returning home from an official school, religious or recreational activity which is supervised by adults and which is sponsored by the City of Maple Lake, Independent School District #881, or by a civic organization which takes responsibility for the minor.

10.04 PENALTY

Any person who violates the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.
