How Does It Work?

The process begins when Wright County issues a message about a potential safety hazard or concern. Next, the Wright County Citizen Alert System sends a message through your primary contact path. If you don't confirm receipt of the message, the system will try to reach your second contact path and continues trying to reach you until you confirm receipt.
