1. **Call to Order** - The special meeting was called to order by Mayor Kissock at 8:24 p.m. following the conclusion of the Maple Lake EDA meeting and the city council work session.

- a. **Consider Massage License Applications**

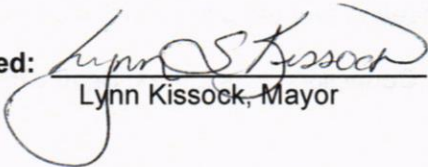

Councilor Hausken seconded the motion and the motion passed. (4-0)**

- ii. **Lan Sky Spa and Yan Tang Therapeutic Massage Enterprise License and Massage Therapist License** – Council discussed the license application for Lan Sky Spa and Yan Tang and asked staff to bring the item back to the March 17 council meeting.
