**CALL TO ORDER**

City of Maple Lake Park Board was called to order by Chairman Brian Guimond at 5:00 pm.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**2020 PARK UPGRADES**

a. **Community and Bolduan Parks**

Sabrina gave an update on the parks that will be installed this spring, the recommendation of purchase was approved by City Council and the purchase was complete. The equipment is already at the maintenance department, and will be installed by the company.

b. **Playground Ground**

Sabrina stated that they needed to discuss the ground that will be in the playground. They discussed about the poured rubber, and how that would be laid and if it would just be in some areas for accessibility. Sabrina will come back at the May meeting with options for the Board to review for the ground, otherwise the option of wood chips would be the most cost effective option. The City will reach out to the Lions to see if they would potentially fund the floor, or contribute to the purchase.

**ICE RINKS**

Deb Geyen wanted to discuss the city to set up and maintain an ice skating rink that is more accessible to the public. The discussion was held on possible locations, and how to best set up the rink and the materials needed. The discussion will be to continue researching on this to hopefully complete an ice rink for this coming winter.

Deb brought up making sure we advertise for the Park Board opening to hopefully get a new member involved on the board and help in decisions.

### **Screening and cement update**

There was discussion past projects that were identified to be completed this year, those projects were to add cement and screening to the port-a-potty at parks within Maple Lake. The board will discuss this at the May Park Board meeting.
