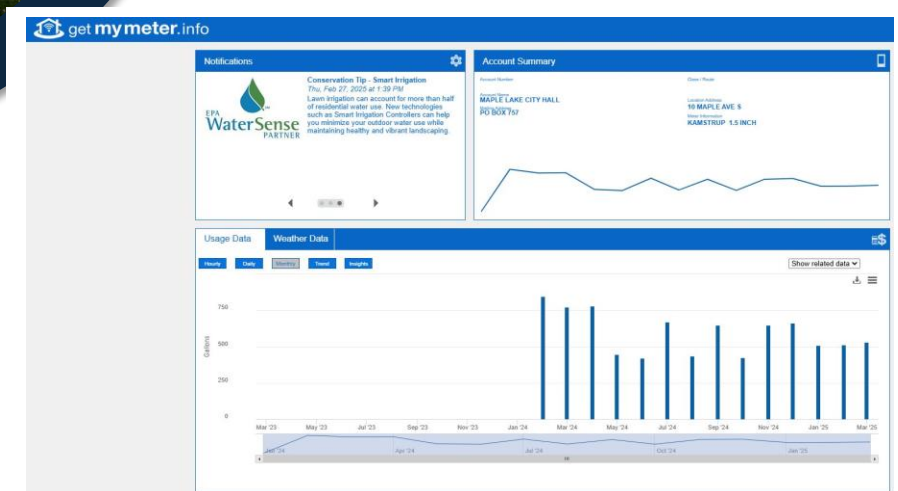

## Customer Portal for Water Meters!



City of Maple Lake Customers now have online access to their water usage information via the Get My Meter Info web portal.

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve services to our Customers, the City of Maple Lake now offers a portal to help you monitor your water usage, offering you direct and secure access to your water usage data.

The Get My Meter Info portal and smartphone app allows you to review and analyze your water usage patterns. With these tools, you are now able to view your usage activity and gain greater understanding and control of the amount of water you use. You are also able to establish alerts, including identifying potential leaks and abnormal increases in your water usage.
